

Housing for ACTC2002:

There is a wide range of housing possibilities for the meeting. One can stay either in the main lodge or in a condo. The condos are on top of the "mountain" 1 - 3 miles away. There will be a free shuttle that runs between the condos and the main lodge.

LODGE: The rooms in the main lodge have two queen-sized beds. The rates are \$98, \$73, \$63/ per person per night, for single, double, or triple occupancy, respectively. This includes taxes and a complimentary buffet breakfast each morning.

CONDO: The condos are of three types – 2-bedroom, 3-bedroom, and 4-bedroom. Most of the condos have two beds in a bedroom, and there is a living room type area. The 2-bedroom condos can accommodate from 2 to 5 people, the 3-bedroom condos from 3 to 7 people, and the 4-bedroom condos from 4 to 9 people. The condos have fully equipped kitchens. Most of the condos are air-conditioned. But even the ones that are not air conditioned should be comfortable evenings, given the location in the Laurel Mountains.

The rental policy on the condos is:

Two-bedroom unit: \$550 for the first two nights, and \$110 each additional night.

Three-bedroom unit: \$710 for the first two nights, and \$120 each additional night.

Four-bedroom unit: \$770 for the first two nights and \$130 each additional night.

Breakfast is not included in the condo fees. Also there is a 6% sales tax and 3% local occupancy tax on the condo fees (not included in the above rates).

The total costs for renting the 2-, 3-, and 4-bedroom condos (not including taxes) for the duration of the meeting (five nights) are: \$880, \$1070, and \$1160, respectively. Thus, the condo rates run from \$25 to \$88 per person per night, depending on the type of condo and how many people you share with. There is a price reduction of 10% if one stays in a non air-conditioned condo.

Reservations: Room reservations should be made directly with Seven Springs, using the housing form on the Registration/Housing portion of the ACTC web page. You can either mail the form to the Resort or call in the reservation. The mailing address and telephone number are on the reservation form. The cut-off date for reservations is June 18. However, to get your first choice, it is best to register as early as possible.

If two or more people are sharing a room or condo, only one room reservation form should be submitted. If you want to share rooms or condos, it is up to you to find roommates; the Seven Springs Resort staff are unable to do this. The secretarial staff associated with the local theory groups may be able to help out somewhat in this context in that we can keep a list of names and e-mails addresses of people looking for roommates. Individuals can then contact other people on this list. If you would like to be added to this list please send your name and e-mail address to actc@pitt.edu with the subject heading "roommate".

Meals: Breakfasts are provided at no extra charge for anyone staying in the main lodge. There are several restaurants in the Seven Springs complex that are open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. There are also several restaurants that are within a few minutes driving distance of the Resort. There will be a BBQ Tuesday evening (the cost for this is covered by the registration fee).
